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| a) Ref Price A - Description | "ELECTRICITY-ERCOT-SOUTH LOAD ZONE-DAY AHEAD" means that the price for a Pricing Date will be that day's Specified Price per MWh of electricity for delivery on the Delivery Date, stated in U.S. Dollars, published by the ERCOT at http://www.ercot.com/content/cdr/html/dam_spp |
| b) Ref Price A - Pricing Date | Each Monday through Friday, excluding NERC holidays, that prices are reported for the Delivery Date |
| c) Ref Price A - Specified Price | Average of SPPs for all hours ending 0700-2200 CPT |
| d) Ref Price A - Pricing calendar | ERCOT |
| e) Ref Price A - Delivery Date | Contract Period |
| Final Payment Date | The sixth Clearing Organization business day following the Last Trading Day |
